Class 1. Prelim 18	Warm up class. This class will only run if team entries (classes 3a, 3b, 4a and 4b) and time allow, entries may be limited and will be taken on a first come first served basis. Class 4a. Junior Winter Novice Team: BRC D10 Test	Area Qualifier. Qualifying teams qualify for Winter Championships. Teams of 4 riders, with 3 scores to count. Two riders will ride BRC D2 Test and two BRC D10 Test	£58 per team
Class 4b. Senior Winter Novice Team: BRC D10 Test	Area Qualifier. Qualifying teams qualify for Winter Championships. Teams of 4 riders, with 3 scores to count. Two riders will ride BRC D2 Test and two BRC D10 Test	£58 per team

Entries:

Preliminary entries for teams must be made by the club representative to the BRC Office 21 days before the Area Qualifier. Prelim entries must be paid directly to BRC via postal entry (see BRC website for printable form) or online entries can be made via the BHS bookshop (www.britishhorse.com). Team entries should be made via the official BRC Area entry form, (download from BRC website) to the Secretary.

Warm up entries for classes 1 & 2 on please use the separate entry form (at the bottom of the schedule) and use a separate cheque (If the classes do not run the cheques will be destroyed).

Area Teams consist of four riders, two ride class 3a or 4a (Junior or Seniors) and two ride class 3b or 4b with the best three scores to count, if there are only three members in a team, all three scores will count. Senior members are 18 years or over on 1st Jan 2015.

CDRC will award Rosettes for Arena placings, 1st to 6th. For the purpose of CDRC Arena placings, no differentiation will be made between Juniors and Seniors

Entry fees:

£10 per rider (CDRC members £8) for warm up classes. £58 per team for BRC Qualifier.

All cheques made payable to CDRC with team name, club and contact number printed on the back.

Times will be available on Area 18 website (<http://www.brc-area18.org.uk>) and on Cheltenham and District Riding Club website (www.cheltenhamridingclub.net) on the Thursday before the competition.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason, the close of prelim entry will remain. However, if the qualifier is moved more than 21 days later, entries will be re-opened but late entry fees cannot be refunded. Eligibility will be approved at the original close of prelim entry.

All hats must have a visible blue BRC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing, to show that it meets the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day to tag your hat if it does not currently have one.

Area Team horses (classes 3a, 3b, 4a and 4b) must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Rulebook. To save time on the competition day, please ensure your passport is uploaded to the Area 18 website. There is also a checking device on the BRC website, but if you are unsure, please call BRC on 02476 840518

Area entries close 10th November 2015

Warm up class entries close 18th November 2015 or earlier if classes are full. Updates will be issued via email and social media.

An RoR RC Challenge Rosette will be awarded to the horse and rider (member or non-member of the club) combination scoring the most points on the day – points are awarded for class placing and participation.

An RoR trophy will be awarded at the end of 2015 to the Cheltenham Riding Club member with an ex racehorse (RoR Registered) accruing the most points at a Cheltenham Riding Club participating competition in 2015 (Summer Show (September 2015 at Abbey Dressage); Halloween Show Jumping (29th October 2015 at Summerhouse); Dressage (warm up classes at the Area competition) (22nd November 2015 at Abbey Dressage).

ROR Challenge Rules:

1. To be eligible your horse must have an RoR number. This number must be placed on your entry form
2. Each Class entered will earn 1 point.

3. Placings in the class will earn points as follows – 1st = 7 points scaling down to 7th= 1 point
4. The winner of the RoR RCC Challenge Rosette will be the horse and rider accruing the most points on the show day; we will endeavour to announce the results on the day of the show; if the show is exceptionally busy then the result will be announced asap and the rosette will be posted to the winner if necessary
5. Points will only be awarded if you are RoR registered on the day of the show, and points cannot be awarded retrospectively.
6. In the event of all eligible competitors being unplaced in a class then the points will be awarded by: The highest % will be given 7pts, the other points being awarded in a similar fashion. Collective marks will be used if required to arrange placings

ADDITIONAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- CDRC will not tolerate any verbal or physical abuse of its members, competitors, spectators or animals and reserves the right to ask any person deemed to be behaving inappropriately to leave the showground.
- Any animal behaving in a manner which may pose a danger to other attendees may be asked to leave the ring / show ground – no refund of entry fees will be made
- Stallions must display a stallion disc at all times
- Horses or ponies must be at least 4 years of age to compete
- A child protection trained member of the CDRC committee is available all day – contact the secretary
- Horses must not be unattended tied to the outside of vehicles. No haynets to be tied to the outside of vehicles
- All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and all fouling must be removed
- Directions of any steward or representative of CDRC must be followed, failure to do so may result in elimination and / or being asked to leave a class / the show ground. No refund of entry fees will be made.
- The judge’s decision and that of the BRC Official Steward is final. Any objections must be made in accordance with BRC rule G14l.
