Mercian Team & individual rosettes to 6th place; Individual & pairs rosettes to 6th place

An RoR RC Challenge Rosette will be awarded to the horse and rider (member or non-member of the CDRC) combination scoring the most points on the day – points are awarded for class placing and participation.

An RoR trophy will be awarded at the end of 2016 to the Cheltenham Riding Club member with an ex racehorse (RoR Registered) accruing the most points at a Cheltenham Riding Club participating competition in that year.

ROR Challenge Rules:

1. To be eligible your horse must have a RoR number. This number must be placed on your entry form
2. Each Class entered will earn 1 point.
3. Placings in the class will earn points as follows – 1st = 7 points scaling down to 7th= 1 point
4. The winner of the RoR RCC Challenge Rosette will be the horse and rider accruing the most points on the show day; we will endeavour to announce the results on the day of the show; if the show is exceptionally busy then the result will be announced asap and the rosette will be posted to the winner if necessary
5. Points will only be awarded if you are RoR registered on the day of the show, and points cannot be awarded retrospectively.

Course to be walked 6pm- 9pm on Friday 22nd April 2016 & will not be deemed complete until 8am on Saturday 23rd April. Any alterations will be posted outside the secretary's box on the day of the competition. **Times will be available on [www.cheltenhamridingclub.net](http://www.cheltenhamridingclub.net) on Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> April.**

**This event will be run under current British Riding Club Rules**

1. **Entries will be limited, please enter all classes as early as possible to avoid disappointment.** The committee reserves the right to alter or vary the schedule or to decline any entry.
2. Hard hats to the current standard BRC (new 2016 rule BSEN1384 is not acceptable on its own) standard must be worn whenever mounted, with the chin strap done up. Fixed peak caps and head cams are NOT allowed.
3. Back Protectors and Medical Arm Bands are compulsory for all classes. Colours may be worn, hunting stocks are recommended.
4. CDRC will not tolerate any verbal or physical abuse of its members, competitors, spectators or animals and reserves the right to ask any person deemed to be behaving inappropriately to leave the showground.
5. Any animal behaving in a manner which may pose a danger to other attendees may be asked to leave the show ground and no refund of entry fees will be made.
6. Horses or ponies must be at least 4 years of age. Horses may not compete more than once in a class. No horse may be entered in more than two classes.
7. A child protection trained member of the CDRC committee is available all day – contact the secretary
8. Horses must not be unattended tied to the outside of vehicles.
9. All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times
10. Directions of any steward or representative of CDRC must be followed, failure to do so may result in elimination and/or being asked to leave a class/show ground. No refund of entry fees will be made. The judges (including jump judges) decision is final. Objections must be handed to the secretary IN

WRITING within 15 minutes of the end of the class together with a £20 deposit. Objections will be dealt with at the end of the day. Any objection not in writing will be dismissed.

11. CDRC, the BHS, BRC and the land owners, accept no responsibility for accident, injury, loss or damage to any horse, vehicles, property, riders, grooms, spectators etc while in attendance at this event
12. Refunds will only be issued on production of a vet/doctors certificate.
