Outdoor Arena Showing starts 0900

- Class 1. Tack and Turn Out
- Class 2. In hand 1 - 3 yr old Potential Riding Club/Pony Club mount
- Class 3. In hand ROR 4 yr old or over
- Class 4. Ridden RC/PC Horse over 15hh
- Class 5. Ridden RC/PC Pony under 15hh
- Class 6. Ridden ROR
- Class 7. Ridden Hunter
- Class 8. Ridden Cob
- Class 9. Ridden Riding Horse
- Class 10. Ridden Coloured
- Class 11. Ridden Veteran 16 yr old or over

Unless stated all ridden classes horses/ponies should be 4 years or over.

Indoor (short) Arena Dressage starts at 0930

- Class 12. Intro B - Potential Young Horse/Pony 4 or 5 yrs old not to have been placed in dressage.
- Class 13. Intro B - Open to all
- Class 14. Prelim 13
- Class 15. Prelim 18/BRC D2 Pick and Mix
- Class 16. Novice 24/BRC D10 Pick and Mix

Outdoor (Long) Arena Dressage starts at 1430

- Class 17. Novice 35
- Class 18. Elementary 40
- Class 19. Pick and Mix Medium 61/Advanced Medium 98

Rosettes 1st to 6th place in all classes. Classes 12 – 16 will be split into Open or Restricted Riders. Restricted combinations must never have been placed 1st in a dressage competition.

Dressage entry fee £10 non-CDRC member, £8 for CDRC members.

Showing entry fee £8 non-CDRC member, £6 for CDRC members.

Entries close Wednesday 16th September; late entries accepted at £1 extra per class. Showing entries accepted on the day. Dressage times will be displayed on www.cheltenhamridingclub.net on the last Thursday before the show. An RoR RC Challenge Rosette will be awarded to the horse and rider (member or non-member of the club) combination scoring the most points on the day – points are awarded for class placing and participation.

An RoR trophy will be awarded at the end of 2015 to the Cheltenham Riding Club member with an ex racehorse (RoR Registered) accruing the most points at a Cheltenham Riding Club participating competition in

2015 (Summer Show (September 2015 at Abbey Dressage); Halloween Show Jumping (29th October 2015 at Summerhouse); Dressage (warm up classes at the Area competition) (22nd November 2015 at Abbey Dressage).

ROR Challenge Rules:

1. To be eligible your horse must have an RoR number. This number must be placed on your entry form
2. Each Class entered will earn 1 point.
3. Placings in the class will earn points as follows – 1st = 7 points scaling down to 7th= 1 point
4. The winner of the RoR RCC Challenge Rosette will be the horse and rider accruing the most points on the show day; we will endeavour to announce the results on the day of the show; if the show is exceptionally busy then the result will be announced asap and the rosette will be posted to the winner if necessary
5. Points will only be awarded if you are RoR registered on the day of the show, and points cannot be awarded retrospectively.
6. In the event of all eligible competitors being unplaced in a class then the points will be awarded as follows
 Show Jumping – least faults in the quickest time will gain 7pts, the other points being awarded in a similar fashion.
 Dressage – the highest % will be given 7pts, the other points being awarded in a similar fashion. Collective marks will be used if required to arrange placings
 Showing – all unplaced will be awarded just the 1 point for participation.

General Rules and Guidance - Please ensure you have read and agree to these rules of entry/attendance.

Entries in some classes will be limited, please enter all classes as early as possible to avoid disappointment
 All classes will be run under British Riding Club rules 2015
 Hard hats to the current standard must be worn whenever mounted, with the chin strap done up
 CDRC will not tolerate any verbal or physical abuse of its members, competitors, spectators or animals and reserves the right to ask any person deemed to be behaving inappropriately to leave the showground.
 Any animal behaving in a manner which may pose a danger to other attendees may be asked to leave the ring/show ground and no refund of entry fees will be made
 Stallions must display a stallion disc at all times
 Horses or ponies must be at least 4 years of age to compete in ridden classes
 A child protection trained member of the CDRC committee is available all day – contact the secretary
 Horses must not be unattended tied to the outside of vehicles. No haynets to be tied to the outside of vehicles
 All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times
 Directions of any steward or representative of CDRC must be followed, failure to do so may result in elimination and/or being asked to leave a class/show ground. No refund of entry fees will be made. The judges decision is final
 [Human] First aid available – contact the secretary
 CDRC, the BHS, BRC and the land owners, accept no responsibility for accident, injury, loss or damage to any horse, vehicles, property, riders, grooms, spectators etc while in attendance at this event
